Dear Mr. Rose,

I have a few more coding concerns regarding the DOT.

One of our users has asked why 159.147-014 DISC JOCKEY and 159.147-010 ANNOUNCER are rated as Light instead of Sedentary since there is nothing in their descriptions to indicate lifting.

Another user has inquired as to the differences between 915.477-010 AUTOMOBILE-SELF-SERVICE-STATION ATTENDANT and 915.467-010 AUTOMOBILE-SERVICE-STATION ATTENDANT:

Stooping is Frequently for Self-Service Attendant but only
Occasionally for Full-Service
Atmospheric Conditions is Frequently for Self-Service and
Never for Full-Service
Other Hazards is Occasionally for Full-Service and Never
for Self-Service (this one may be okay)

Also, there is no Dishwasher occupation anywhere in the DOT, not even as an Alternate Title for 318.687-010 KITCHEN HELPER

The DOT occupation 910.167-010 CAR CHASER is assigned only to the Beverage industry. Would this also fit into the Railroad industry? If so, would CAR-DUMPER-OPERATOR-HELPER also belong to an industry besides Beverage?

I am aware, per correspondence from you dated July 12,1993, that you are compiling changes and will release them to all clients at some unspecified date in the future. Are you any closer to issuing a release?
